(Funded by NJ Transit)

A transportation program offered to Livingston residents 62 years of age & older and disabled residents 18 years of age and older to any Livingston location including Township programs, YMCA, Public Library, ShopRite, Livingston Mall and JCC in West Orange. The wheelchair accessible bus runs Monday - Friday, 8:45 am - 4:00 pm.

An additional vehicle is available when it becomes necessary.

Reservations may be made one week to twenty-four hours in advance of the desired ride.

COVID-19 Guidelines

**SYLS Age Friendly transportation resumed
Aug 2020 with the following guidelines:**

- Both Drivers and Riders **MUST** wear a mask at all times.
- Capacity will be limited to a maximum of 50%
- Rider's must only sit in designated seats; seats **WILL** be limited and spaced accordingly.
- Drivers will sanitize and disinfect hand rails and seats in between each rider
- Hand Sanitizer will be available on the bus for Driver and Riders
- We will not be offering Group trips at this time.
- Any rider who shows signs of being symptomatic should not ride the bus.



- The bus will be disinfected in entirety at the end of every shift
- if weather allows, 2 windows will be left open to increase airflow inside the bus.

Please understand that appointments may be limited due to extra time being needed to disinfect between riders.
