Group Assignments

Children are placed in groups based on their age. There are 3 groups for each Preschool & Kindergarten camp. Each group will have an adult Group Leader, Counselors, and CIT. Clothing

Camp can be a messy place at times! Please dress children in durable play clothes. Weather permitting, water play activities will be offered every day. For the safety of your child, please have them wear **sneakers with socks** to camp. **We encourage children to wear a bathing suit to camp & bring a towel & dry clothing in their backpack daily.** Please apply sunscreen prior to arrival each day. Staff may reapply sunscreen; if needed, **please be sure to bring the spray sunscreen only & advise the head leaders.**

Snack & Lunch

We are NOT a peanut-free environment. If possible, we ask that you **not** send snacks to camp that contain peanut products. **Snacks or treats provided by the Township WILL BE PEANUT FREE!** Each day, half-day and full-day campers will have a snack time. Please pack a snack and a water bottle or juice box. Full-day campers will eat lunch at 12:25 PM. If your child has a peanut allergy, we will provide a peanut-free table. Please make sure the lunch box is labeled with your child's first and last name. Lunch boxes will be kept indoors in your child's assigned groups bin. Please do not pack any food that needs to be heated.

Water Play

Weather permitting, water play activities will be offered every day. Campers will get to splash in baby pools, run through sprinklers, play with water tables, and much more! Please dress your child in a bathing suit, and pack a towel and a change of clothes.

Northland Pool Days

On Pool Days, **Preschool, Kindergarteners, & 1st Graders will be dropped off at Northland Pool (regardless of weather,)** where they will have the opportunity to play at the Spray Park/Pool for the whole morning. Preschoolers & Kindergarteners will remain in the Splash 'N Spray area, water depth never exceeds 18 inches, and swim lessons are not required. 1st Graders will remain in the shallow end in the big pool. Lifeguards are always on duty. If it rains, indoor activities will be held at Northland on these days.

Pick up will be at 12:00 PM at Northland Pool for half-day campers. Full-day campers will be bussed back to Mount Pleasant Middle School for lunch and afternoon activities. Please dress in a bathing suit and pack a towel; full-day campers should bring a change of clothes. All campers will eat a snack at the pool. Please see the camp calendar for your child's assigned pool days.

Playground

Preschoolers, Kindergarteners, & 1st Graders will have the opportunity to play on the playground at Mount Pleasant Middle School daily.

Registration

Registration begins Monday, March 11th. Registration fees include either half day or full day of camp beginning Monday, June 24th and ending on Friday, August 9th. All daily activities, special events, and a camp t-shirt are included.

Policy for Late Pick Ups

There will be a fee for late pick ups. The fee will be \$10 for every 15 minutes late. Half day campers must be picked up by 12:15 pm, Full day campers must be picked up by 2:30 pm. Ex: If your child is a half day camper, and you pick up between 12:30-12:45, you will be charged \$10 through Community Pass. If your child is a full day camper and is picked up between 3:00-3:15, you will be charged \$20 through Community Pass.

Welcome

Get set for an exciting, fun and adventurous summer camp experience! You'll enjoy many indoor and outdoor games, arts and crafts, dress-up days, and exciting special events. There will be weekly swimming trips by bus to Northland Pool and optional field trips to locations throughout New Jersey. Campers will also have the opportunity to participate in our annual Camp Play. There's always a world of fun right around the corner at Livingston Kids' Camp! Every year we add new and exciting special events, activities and field trips!

Arrival

Drop off begins no earlier than 8:00 AM, unless pre registered for Pre-Camp Drop Off. You will see our camp staff directing traffic in front of Heritage Middle School. Please follow the traffic pattern. A staff member will assist your child from your vehicle to their group. You are always welcome to park your car in the main parking lot at Heritage Middle School and walk your child to camp.

Clothing

Camp is a fun place ~ dress casually! We encourage campers to wear durable play clothes and sneakers with socks. Bathing suits and a towel are strongly recommended on swim days. Please apply sunscreen prior to arrival each day. Staff will not apply sunscreen unless it is in a spray can. Children can reapply themselves. Campers may also get wet with our afternoon cool-down activities.

Lunch

We are NOT a peanut-free environment. Please notify Camp Nurse, Camp Director, and Counselors if your child is allergic and if you would like your child to sit at a peanut-free lunch table. Simply Gourmet food service and **any snacks or treats provided by the Township WILL BE PEANUT FREE**. Please pack a lunch for your child attending a full day, and mark your child's bag with their name and grade. Lunches will be collected upon arrival and stored in the cafeteria. Children staying a half-day will not have a lunch period. All children should pack a water bottle. Water will also be available in coolers and water fountains throughout camp.

Catered "Hot Lunch" Program

Our camp has teamed up with Simply Gourmet, a full-service school lunch provider. They will cook and deliver a hot meal right to the camp site! You can go online, pick your meals and pay in advance. Beginning in June 2020, this service will be available online at www.simplygourmetlunches.com. Additional fees apply for Simply Gourmet. For all questions regarding your child's food orders, please contact Simply Gourmet directly.

Dismissal

Half-day campers will be released between 11:45- 12:00 PM. Full-day campers will be released between 2:45-3:00 PM. Please follow our traffic pattern during dismissal. **To make pickup a quicker process for everyone, we ask parents to write your child's name and group on an INDEX CARD.** If you are carpooling, please make sure all children are listed on the index card (For Example: JOHN SMITH- Boys 2, KELLY SMITH- Girls 6 and CHARLES- Boys 7/8). Administrative staff will read the index card over the radio and your child will be escorted by a camp counselor to your vehicle. A main parking lot is also available if you prefer to park and walk to your child's group.

Policy for Late Pick Ups

There will be a fee for late pick ups. The fee will be \$10 for every 15 minutes late. Half day campers must be picked up by 12:00 pm, Full day campers must be picked up by 3:00 pm. Ex: If your child is a half day camper, and you pick up between 12:15- 12:30, you will be charged \$10 through Community Pass. If your child is a full day camper and is picked up between 3:30-3:45, you will be charged \$20 through Community Pass.

Camp Medical Paperwork

Any camper who needs to see the nurse daily to take doctor-prescribed medication must have a doctor complete the **Camp Medical Form**. Please drop off Medical Forms and medications directly to the Camp Nurse on the first day of camp. Put all medications in a Ziploc bag labeled with your camper's name and group. All medications must be in the original container.

IMPORTANT: Any child who lists any **nut allergies** must bring their Epi-Pen and Action Plan to camp. If your camper's prescription lists two Epi-Pens, the SYLS Camp Nurse **MUST** have both.
