A collaboration between the Alcohol and Drug Abuse Prevention Team (ADAPT), local pharmacists and Livingston Police Department.

Adults ages 62 may bring any prescription and over-the-

counter medications with them for a pharmacist's review. The goal is to collect any old and unused medication and dispose of it. A secondary role is to educate local senior citizens on their overall health and wellness, medication misuse, the issues with prescription medication theft, and methods to prevent theft, etc. The program will begin with a brief presentation, then seniors will meet one-on-one with a pharmacist for a free consultation, and they may drop off any old or unused medication for disposal with the Police Department. ADAPT will provide snacks and refreshments.
