**SPECIFIC NOTICE REGARDING THE FLOOD HAZARD AREA PERMIT APPLICATION**

This letter is to notify you that Public Service Electric and Gas Company ("PSE&G") is submitting an application for a flood hazard area verification to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) for property described in the attached application form. The Department regulates construction within flood hazard areas and riparian zones adjacent to certain waters. This application request is for the Department to verify the extent of these areas on the subject properties. In addition, PSE&G is also submitting an application for a flood hazard area permit to the Department for the project described on the attached application form. A flood hazard area permit is required for this project because some or all of the work is proposed in a flood hazard area or riparian zone. The application is for the construction of the proposed Susquehanna-Roseland 500 kilovolt (kV) transmission line, temporary construction access roads, a new switching station in Hopatcong Borough, Sussex County and a new switching station in the Borough of Roseland, Essex County.

## Notice to Neighboring Landowners and Local Agencies

Due to the unique size, linear nature and scope of the proposed transmission line project, hardship exceptions under N.J.A.C. 7:13-9.8 are also being requested for the following:

- Regulated activities in riparian zones, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:13-10.2; as the total area of riparian zone disturbance exceeds the allowable limits associated with some of the structures and some temporary access road stream crossings, as per the regulations;
- Regulated activities in floodways, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:13-10.3; since a limited number of proposed structures must unavoidably be located within the floodway to maintain the transmission line alignment that was established based on a rigorous route selection process;
- Regulated activities in the flood fringe, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:13-10.4; as a limited number of proposed structures are unavoidably located in the flood fringe to maintain the transmission line alignment that was established based on a rigorous route selection process; and
- Definition of “temporary” as it applies to the projected duration of proposed temporary construction access roads and stream crossings; as portions of the proposed project cannot be completed within the six (6)-month limit for temporary projects that is defined in N.J.A.C. 7:13-1.2 based on the project’s overall size and scope.

### SPECIFIC RE-NOTICE<sup>1</sup> REGARDING THE INDIVIDUAL FRESHWATER WETLANDS PERMIT APPLICATION

PSE&G is also sending you this letter to inform you that the company is resubmitting an application for a permit approval to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) under the Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act rules, N.J.A.C. 7:7A. The requested permit approvals will authorize the company to conduct regulated activities on the transmission line right-of-way and along the proposed access roads.

PSE&G is applying for a Freshwater Wetlands Individual Permit (FWIP), an open water fill permit and transition area waivers for all the work associated with the construction of the upgraded transmission line including: new utility structures; access roads and two (2) new switching stations, one to be located in Hopatcong Township<sup>2</sup> the other in the Borough of Roseland, Essex County.

These approvals will authorize the regulated activities including: filling; cutting of vegetation; and the placement of utility structures or access roads within wetlands, open waters or the buffer adjacent to a wetland, known as a transition area. Such work includes construction of physical improvements or grading activity to support the construction. Disturbed areas will be restored and stabilized through provisions included in approved Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Plans.

If you would like to inspect a copy of the Freshwater Wetlands Individual Permit Application, it is on file at the Municipal Clerk's Office in all of the 16 municipalities listed above, through which the project is proposed to traverse; or you may call the NJDEP at (609) 777-0456 to make an appointment to see the application at the NJDEP offices in Trenton during normal business hours.

The rules governing freshwater wetlands permits and approvals are found in the NJDEP's Freshwater Wetlands Protection Act rules at N.J.A.C. 7:7A. You can view or download these rules on the NJDEP Land Use Regulation Program website at [www.state.nj.us/dep/landuse](http://www.state.nj.us/dep/landuse) or you can generally find a copy of these rules within the county law library of your county courthouse.

As part of the NJDEP's review of PSE&G's application, NJDEP personnel may visit the existing right-of-way and the portion of any neighboring property that lies within 150 feet of the right-of-way, to perform a site inspection. This site inspection will involve only a visual inspection and possibly minor soil borings using a four-inch (4") diameter hand auger. The inspection will not result in any damage to vegetation or to property improvements.

With regards to the FWIP, the NJDEP welcomes any comments you may have on the application. Comments should be submitted to the NJDEP *in writing* within 30 days after the





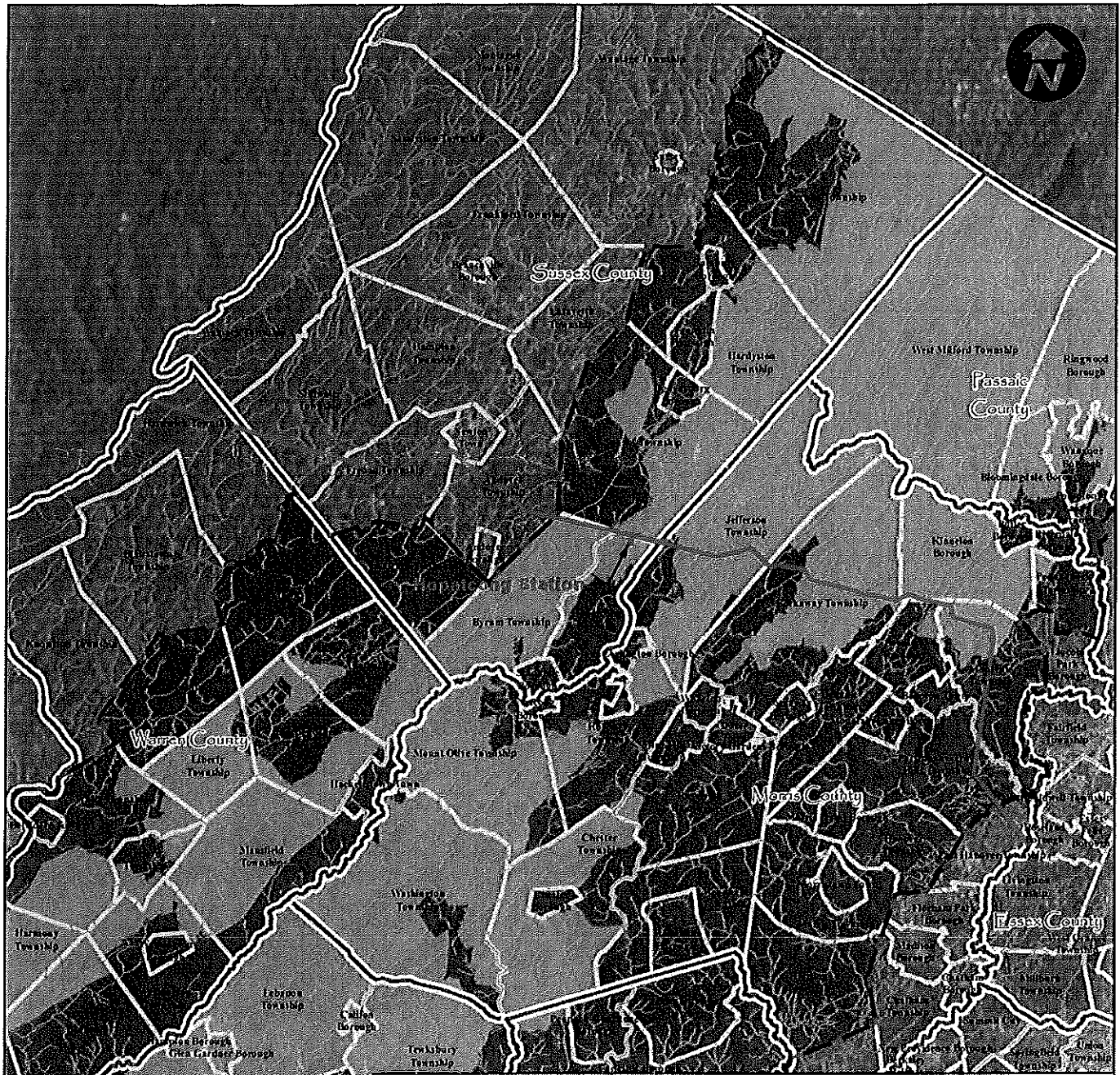
