

ORDINANCE No. 18-2013

**ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LIVINGSTON AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 57
ALARM MONITORING SYSTEMS BY AMENDING SECTION 57-7 FINES**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Livingston, County of Essex, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. The following language is added to Sections 57-7 Fines:

§57-7 Fines.

(1) An Alarm User shall be subject to fines, depending on the number of False Alarms within any calendar year, based upon the following schedule:

- a. For the first False Alarm in any given calendar year, a warning shall be issued.
- b. For the second False Alarm a fine shall be paid to the Township in the amount of \$100.00.
- c. For the third and each subsequent False Alarm in the same calendar year, the fine shall be increased by \$50.00 increments, with no cap on the amount of the fine and shall be paid to the Township.

(for example: 1st false alarm – warning; 2nd false alarm - \$100.00 fine; 3rd false alarm - \$150.00 fine; 4th false alarm - \$200.00 fine, etc.)

SECTION 2. Except as hereby amended, the Code of the Township of Livingston shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty days from final passage and publication in accordance with the law.
